### III. Update Westhampton Issues from Mark and Niki (Health Director, Health Agent

- A. MB discusses a Facebook post from Wind Water at 71 Northwest Rd. regarding offering food at public events at their property.
  - 1. MB has reached out to the owners and left a voicemail.

# IV. Public Hearing to Discuss Variance Request for 71 Pine Island Lake

- A. KB made motion to suspend BoH meeting and open the Public Hearing

- 3. Unanimous
- D. MB discusses variance request for septic system
  - 1. Owners are requesting a variance to the 50 foot setback to the lake (asking 26 feet.)
  - 2. MB explains the limitations to the lot and lack of alternative options/areas to put the system
  - 3. MB states the Conservation Commission has approved the plan in its current location
  - 4. JT asked of this technology required inspections
  - 5. BD explained that some I/A systems require operation and maintenance plans
  - 6. LI asked if her well was within the setback area
  - 7. BD and MB explained that the engineer is required to identify any wells within the minimum setbacks in Title 5
  - 8. MB will confirm with the engineer that no other wells (neighbors) are within the setback area.
- E. BD makes a motion to close the public hearing.
  - 1. KB seconds
  - 2. All agree.
- F. BD makes a motion to approve the request to reduce the required minimum Title 5 setbacks to: 26' to surface waters, 50' to the owners well, and 8.6' 60 the property line.
  - 1. KB Seconds
  - 2. All in favor
- G. BD makes another motion to close Public Hearing
  - 1. KB seconds
  - 2. All in favor
- H. BD makes motion to reopen the BoH Meeting
  - 1. KB seconds
  - 2. All in favor.
