



Westhampton Board of Health
Minutes to meeting of June 18th, 2020
Call to order at 1:01pm and adjourned at 1:42

Present: in person : Robby Armenti (RA), David Blakesley (DB), Tom Martin (TM), Mark Bushee (MB) Bill Jablonski (BJ), and present remotely: Ginny Curtis (GC), Shirley Morgon (SM)

- 1) DB moves to approve minutes of June 11th, 2020 meeting with RA seconding and motion passing unanimously.
- 2) MB update Board on Outlook Farm enforcement noting that Department of Labor Standards (DLS) has moved forward notice of \$300. Fine for non-compliance of Covid requirements and requires corrective action by 6/19/20. MB notes that these two DLS actions have been hand delivered by him at DLS request. MB notes issue of non-compliance is on-going and also that owner has requested a hearing on the matter with DLS.
- 3) DB reports on Covid-kit outreach with about half of kits distributed at transfer station on Wed. evening and the rest to be distributed this Saturday. DB notes everyone at transfer station had a mask to wear while at the transfer station and was aware of the social distancing and facial covering protocols.
- 4) BJ on updates to transfer station with new dual stream recycling system in place for July 1st requirement for separation of paper and cardboard from rest of household recyclables. Board to provide support attendant in this transition phase. BJ notes July 1st the rest of the transfer station services will be open (i.e. swap shed, scouts shed for bottle donations.)
- 5) Board discusses further purchases of PPE and coordinating with Foothills on Bulk purchase. RA notes that sanitizer may be helpful to have as well as face coverings.
- 6) MB reports no new cases of Covid in the District. MB notes that Title V work has increased dramatically.
- 7) SM with question on Town Meeting safety plans.
- 8) GC with question on permitting and inspections at KOA campground.
