Proposed Regulations Westhampton Board of Health

- 1) The Westhampton Board of Health or its designated agent shall witness for a fee, all septic systems inspections under its authority, and as required by 310 CMR 15:00. The Board or its agent may require a deep observation hole be dug and witnessed by the Board or its agent to determine or verify the estimated seasonal high ground water as it relates to the septic systems leaching components.
- 2) The Westhampton Board of Health or its designated agent shall issue a permit for a fee, all residential and commercial drinking water wells under its authority. A well completion report and a potable water test shall be submitted to the Board after the completion of the well as a mandatory part of the well permit. Prior to construction of the well the Board or its agent may require that the exact well location be staked prior to a site visit. Prior to construction of the well, the Board or its agent may require that the well location be placed on a surveyed map showing well and septic locations on adjacent properties.
