Westhampton Property and Energy Assessment Committee Meeting March 10, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 5:37 pm.

Dave brought the Town Hall floor refinishing spec and info to the Finance Committee on March 4. We may be able to use money left over from the roof, after gutters are paid for. Chris still hadn't been able to reach Mr.Labreque for an additional estimate, and it was agreed to drop that request.

Chris reported that Todd Alexander might be interested in the door replacement work.

Dave brought up that if the Salt Shed is staying in existence, it will need to be painted or stained. Mikki Nevins, a library trustee, asked if we would handle getting estimates for painting the older part of the library. Barbara will add these to our building maintenance task list.
