GREETINGS:

IN THE NAME OF the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said WESTHAMPTON on MONDAY the twenty-second day of FEBRUARY next, at 7:30 o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from available funds, or otherwise provide, the sum of \$25,000.00, in order to pay the Town's share of a litigation settlement in a pending MCAD employment case, "Levis A. Robbins, Jr. v. Town of Westhampton", which also includes a separate payment by the Town's insurer, or take any action relative thereto.



Finance Committee voted 6-yes, 1-abstain, 0-no to transfer \$25,000.00.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the FY16 Highway Materials Account to the Chapter 90 Account, or take any action relative thereto.

Finance Committee voted 7- 0-0 to transfer \$15,104.10 from the FY16 Highway Materials Account to the Chapter 90 Account.


And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up attested copies thereof at the TOWN HALL fourteen days, at least before the time of holding said meeting.
