Dear Phil, Maureen, and Teri,

After this particularly difficult year, I wanted to ensure that the seniors' last week was particularly memorable. That was made possible by the strong and constant efforts from these Westhampton community members.

- Fire Chief Dave Antosz supported my plan to host a bonfire for the seniors on June 1. Even when I contacted him late in the evening the night of the bonfire, he came right up to the library with his two sons to assist me.
