## MINUTES of the MEETING Monday, March 27, 2023, at 6:30 PM

The Westhampton Selectboard scheduled a regular meeting to be held on Monday, March 27, 2023, at 6:30 PM at the Town Offices, 1 South Road, and via video-conference.<sup>1</sup>

#### Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 PM by Maureen Dempsey, Chair pro temp.

#### PRESENTATION / DISCUSSION – John Shaw – Zoning Bylaw Review Committee

Mr. Shaw made a presentation, spoke about the work of the Committee, and provided some recommendations about what the Selectboard might consider moving forward. No action taken.

#### Highway (Bill Jablonski)

Mr. Jablonski provided an update on work completed by the highway department, including receipt of the new tractor, significant snow-plowing operations, chipping of brush throughout the town after recent storms, cutting of brush on roadsides, shelving on mezzanine at the highway building, reorganizing the garage bays, and post-storm cleanups, including waterway management, equipment management, etc.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### Treasurer / Financial Services

After brief deliberation, it was MOVED by Johndrow, SECONDED by Dempsey, to

*Increase the proposed salary of the Treasurer to \$42,000* 

*Increase the proposed salary of the Collector to \$28,000* 

Change the description of the Treasurer's job description from "appointed, salaried, non-benefited position" to "appointed, exempt, benefitted position" and remove number of hours worked per week from the job description.

Change the description of the Tax Collector's job description from "appointed, salaried, non-benefited position" to "appointed, exempt, non-benefitted position" and remove number of hours worked per week from the job description.

Increase the requested FY2024 appropriation request for account #015161.704, "Training-Treas, Coll, T.Clerk" from \$2,000 to \$5,000.

Ms. Dempsey noted that the changes seem necessary at this time, and will provide the greatest freedom to the town going forward.

#### NEW BUSINESS (May include items not reasonably anticipated at the time of posting)

A request for a promissory letter as requested by Westhampton Veterans Agent Joe Henning was reviewed. The letter agrees to commit \$750 in fuel assistance to a widow of a veteran, in accordance with the ongoing program administered by Mr. Henning, in order to enable a delivery of heating oil to be delivered to the beneficiary, a widow of 80+ years of age currently without heat.
