At the Annual Town Elections for the inhabitants of the Town of Westhampton qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, duly warned and held in the Town Hall on June 2, 2001, the following were the results of such:--

ARTICLE 1: To elect by ballot necessary officers to serve the ensuing year, and vote on Questions Number One, Two and Three.

QUESTION 1: Shall the Town of Westhampton be allowed to exempt from the limitations of proposition two and one-half, so called, the amounts needed to pay for its allocable portion of the Bonds issued by the Hampshire Regional School District for reconstructing, adding to, equipping, remodeling or making extraordinary repairs to existing District school facilities, including the payment of all other costs incidental and related thereto?

QUESTION 2: Shall the Town of Westhampton accept sections 3 to 7, inclusive of Chapter 44B of the General Laws, as approved by its legislative body, a summary of which appears below? SUMMARY:

Sections 3 to 7 of Chapter 44B of the General Laws of Massachusetts, also known as the Community Preservation Act ("Act"), establishes a dedicated funding source to acquire, create and preserve open space, historic resources, land for recreational use, and community housing, and to rehabilitate and restore, such open space, historic resources, land for recreational use and community housing acquired or created as provided under said Act. In Westhampton, the act will be funded by an additional surcharge of 1% on the annual tax levy on real property and by matching funds provided by the state. Any taxpayer receiving an exemption of real property authorized by Chapter 59 of the General Laws or any other law shall be exempt from the Act, and the surcharge to be paid by a taxpayer receiving an abatement of real property authorized by said Chapter 59 or any other law shall be reduced in proportion to the amount of the abatement. A Community Preservation Committee must be created pursuant to by-law and will make recommendations on the use of the funds. Town Meeting must approve any such recommendations before funds can be expended to acquire any particular parcel of land.

QUESTION 3: Shall the Town of Westhampton be allowed to assess an additional \$28,000 in real estate and personal property taxes for the purpose of purchasing a brush truck for the fire department for the fiscal year beginning July first, two thousand and one?
