NEW! Our library now has a new Young Adult Nonfiction section of books that appeal to or inform teens about relevant topics.

Museum passes continue to be a popular library feature, especially during summer and school vacations. Passes provide free or discounted admission to several western Massachusetts museums.

The four learning kits, chemistry kits and celestial telescope continue to circulate frequently. The kits contain everything you need to learn these new skills. Ukelele, anyone? Learn some Spanish, try bird-watching or orienteering. Do you have suggestions for more?

This summer, the Friends will raffle off a beautiful quilt of many colors. Look for it on display in the library and at all of the concerts on the lawn this summer, beginning with Johnny & the Flashbacks on June 21st.

Most membership renewals include an additional donation to the Fill the Shelves initiative.

The Lyn Keating Programming Fund attracted \$2,000 in donations in 2018. These funds allow the Friends board to vote "YES" when Lynn and Sara suggest new programs.

Recent statistics show that nationwide, **less than 43%** of donors to non-profits donate again the following year. Fortunately, we exceed 43%, but we're not at 100%.
