Or take any action thereon or in relation thereto.

Motion made and seconded to pass over the article - Motion carried

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will vote to enact Article 7 of the Town of Westhampton General Bylaws, entitled "Stretch Energy Code" for the purpose of regulating the design and construction of buildings for the effective use of energy, pursuant to Appendix 115.AA of the Massachusetts Building Code, 780 CMR, the Stretch Energy Code, including future editions, amendments or modifications thereto, with an effective date of July 1, 2019 a copy of which is on file with the Town Clerk, or take any other action relative thereto.

Motion made and seconded that the Town will enact Article 9 of the Town of Westhampton General Bylaws, entitled "Stretch Energy Code" for the purpose of regulating the design and construction of buildings for the effective use of energy, pursuant to Appendix 115.AA of the Massachusetts Building Code, 780 CMR, the Stretch Energy Code, including future editions, amendments or modifications thereto, with an effective date of July 1, 2019.

Jim Barry, Regional Coordinator, Green Communities Division, Dept. of Energy Resources was allowed to provide information on the Green Communities Program and Stretch Code and answered questions.

Motion made and seconded to hold secret vote – Motion carried.

Steve Holt and Brad Morse were sworn in as counters. Final count was votes cast: 43 Yes 5 No 1 Blank Motion passed.

Motion was made and seconded and unanimously approved to dissolve the Special Town Meeting at 8:17 PM
